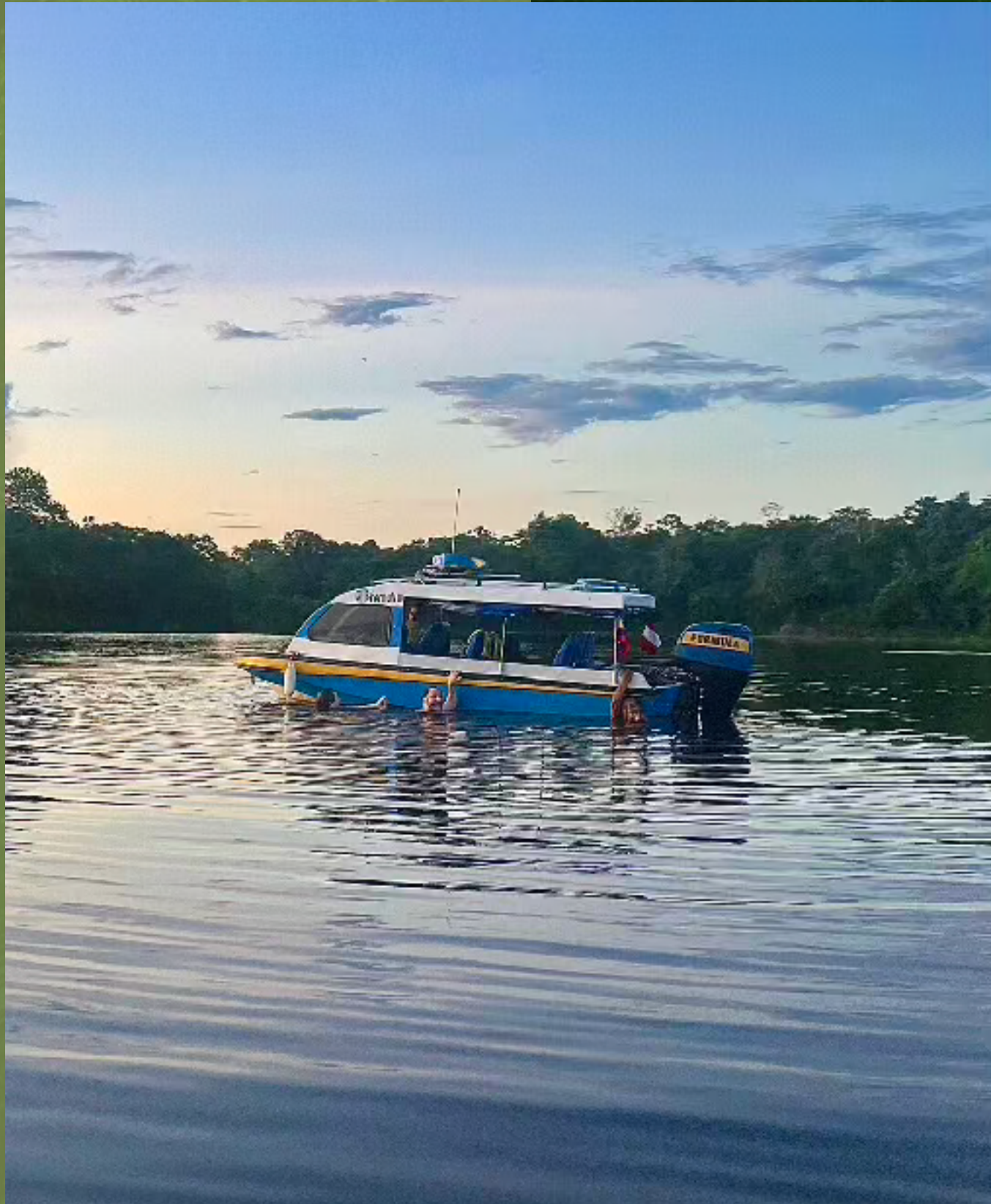

### **PUERTO NARIÑO**

boat transfer to Puerto Nariño with typical lunch, village walk, viewpoint visit, dinner,

### **WOCHINE & TARAPOTO LAKE**

walk to Wochine reserve, lunch in the village, lake trip for dolphins or piranha fishing

### **SLOTH & WILDLIFE MORNING**

boat trip to Peruvian villages, forest walk to spot sloths and birds

4

### **LETICIA**

The last stop from our tour, the biggest city of the Colombian Amazon.

# Day 1: Puerto Nariño

We welcome you at the airport and head to the port to take a boat to Puerto Nariño. We will enjoy a typical lunch and enjoy amazing views from the viewpoint. We will have time to walk around the village before having dinner. We end our day with dinner at the hotel or we can take you out to explore some typical local street food

Accommodation: Private Room with Private Bathroom at a Hotel in Puerto Nariño





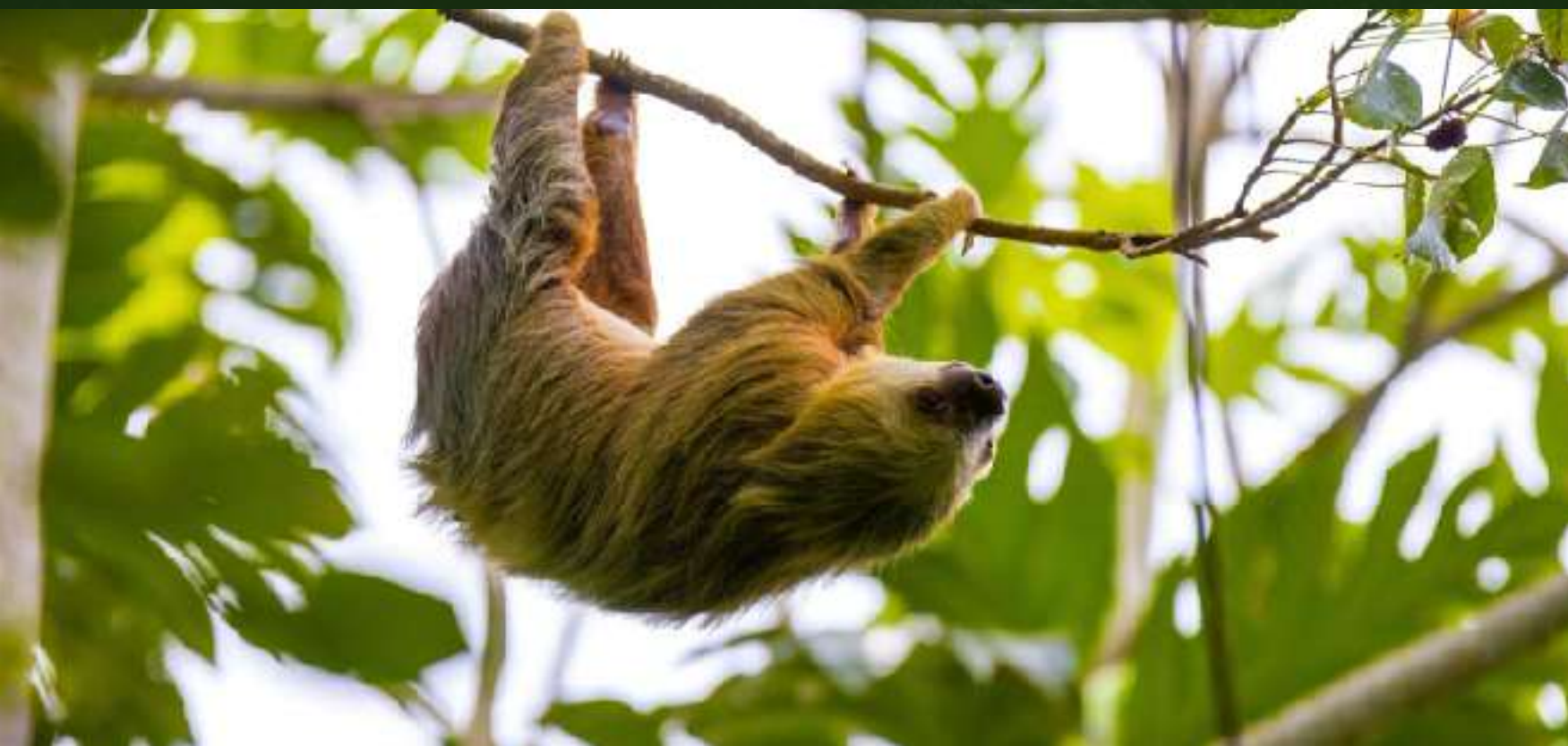
## Day 2: Wochine & Tarapoto Lake

We will have breakfast at the hotel and then take a morning walk to the Wochine reserve. We will have time to explore the fauna and flora before heading back to the village for lunch. Afterwards, we take a private boat to the Lakes close by to spot pink and grey dolphins, swim or go Piranha fishing. We will end the day with dinner at a local restaurant.

Accommodation: Either in rooms with double beds (couples) or a room with multiple beds (groups)



## **Day 3: Sloth & Wildlife Morning**



After breakfast, take a scenic boat ride down the Amazon to the Peruvian villages of Isla Cacao and San Antonio.

Stroll through the forest with your guide in search of three-toed sloths and colorful birds, while learning about local life and traditions. Return to Puerto Nariño in time for lunch. Afternoon to explore and walk around the town.



## Day 4: Leticia

We will have breakfast early in the morning and take the boat to Leticia, which will take us around 2 hours. We will then drop you off in town or take you to the airport as requested.
